2012 Budget Meeting May 26, 2011

Present: Budget Officer Muscarella, Supervisor Jones, Councilor Parson, Highway Superintendent Payne, Bookkeeper McKay, Town Clerk McMichael.

Budget Officer Muscarella presented his concerns with discussion outcomes noted:

- 1. Justice Davison are benefits to remain as in 2011 budget?

  Bookkeeper McKay will contact Sprague Insurance for input regarding continuation of his policy.
- Is there a need to obtain benefit quotes?
   No need for medical insurance. A quote on the dental insurance quote to be considered.
- 3. Planning Board members compensation.

  Compensation is currently shown as mileage. Councilor Parson will check with both the Planning and Zoning Boards to determine if they would like a 15% increase to cover tax on current rate.
- 4. Youth Program Appropriations/Revenue for 2012?

  County funds decreased about \$800. Program expenses will be decreased. Town will fund the difference.
- 5. 5Highway Equipment purchases Is the long range plan still in effect or should changes be made?
  Plan is feasible. No new plan.
- 6. Cemetery funding? Yes, same as 2011.
- 7. Keuka College consideration of Payments in Lieu of Taxes. To be considered on project by project basis.
- 8. Changes to Budget Submission sheets. "Prepared by", "Approved by" and "Date" will be added to sheets.
- 9. Budget Timetables. Same as last year.
- 10.Salary/Wage & Benefits increases (if any).
  Bookkeeper McKay to obtain COLA information. Payne to talk to Highway employees. Personnel Committee to develop job descriptions.
- 11.Library stays the same.
