All conditions of Town Code section 93:19-27 must be met, including a site plan of the lots and the private road, which is to be provided to the Planning Board, CEO, Highway Superintendent, Water and Sewer Superintendent, Fire Chief, and Yates County Soil and Water (YCSW) for review and comments **prior** to the application being considered by the Planning Board. The Planning Board's recommendations must then be reviewed and acted upon by the Town Board before any work can begin.

A Pre-Construction meeting will be required involving CEO, Highway, Water and Sewer, Fire Chief and possibly YCSW before any road construction can begin.

A Building Permit, if applicable, shall not be issued until a final decision by the Town Board on the proposed Private Road has been made.

• It has been determined the process flow chart developed in 2012 needs to be utilized with signatures acknowledging receipt to ensure involved parties understand the required process.
